MINUTES

Mr. McMillan called the meeting to order. It was moved by Mr. Herrman, seconded by Mrs. Teener to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting on January 7, 2008. On vote, motion carried 6-0.

Mr. Loupe explained that the drainage study for the Northwing subdivision has been completed and is not appropriate for parkland.

Mr. Loupe explained that an offer of land has been presented to the City for parkland.
