MINUTES

CITY POOL UPDATE

City Park Pool closed for the season on June 24, 2008. Mr. Loupe complimented Mrs. Kathy Swan, Recreation Supervisor, for being innovative in creating accommodations for Little Apple Day Camp participants who use the pool every afternoon. Refunds are being processed for a half session of the swimming lessons and pool tags are being prorated. Calls are being made to offer lessons at CiCo or Northview pools.

Mr. Loupe discussed the engineer's report of City Park Pool. The Board appreciated receiving the tour of City Pool earlier this year. Discussion was held on construction of a new pool. Board Members stated that the pool should be built big enough and to "do it right" from the start.

Mr. Pesaresi stated that he felt that the Anneberg Park playground area is being used as a dog park.
