**1. Report on the Manhattan Archaeological Survey from Lauren Ritterbush, Associate Professor at Kansas State & Project Director**

Lauren Ritterbush presented the results of the Manhattan Archaeological Survey. Ritterbush described the types of sites and artifacts identified through the project and provided recommendations for further survey work and methods of preservation.

The Board discussed the development of a list of priorities for future potential surveys and protection of archaeological resources.

It was noted that Ritterbush would be giving a public presentation about the Survey project on August 13<sup>th</sup>.
