Ms. Teener called the meeting to order. It was moved by Mr. Pesaresi, seconded by Mr. Montenegro to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting on February 1, 2010. On vote, motion carried 5-0.

CITY PARK ROAD

Mr. Loupe explained the City Park Master Plan was approved in November 2006, which included road improvements. He discussed the recommended layout of the roads with the board. The board held discussion on the entrance/exit of Fremont and 11th Streets, water standing at the entrance to the park on Leavenworth Street, keeping a portion of the road available for parades, potholes, one-way traffic, charging parking fees, etc.

Mr. Loupe will continue to pursue the new parking/roadway for City Park.

Gibbon Exhibit Update

Mr. Shoemaker explained that the majority of the demo work has been finished for the exhibit and the plans have been completed. The project will be going out for bid during the summer.
