The following members of the Cemetery Advisory Board were present: Ms. Judy Atwood, Mr. Patrick Gormely, Mr. Lawrence Pollack, and Mr. Eric Londeen. Mr. Dennis Irvin arrived later. Mr. Stephen Konz and Ms. Deborah Saroff were absent at this meeting. Also present at this meeting were Mr. Mike Mohler, Cemetery Sexton, and Mrs. Buffy Woodward, Administrative Assistant.

Mr. Gormely called the meeting to order.

MINUTES

It was moved by Ms. Atwood, seconded by Mr. Gormely to approve the minutes. On vote, motion carried 4-0.

SEXTON'S REPORT

Mr. Mohler explained that revenue for Sunset Cemetery year-to-date was \$7,000; revenue for Sunrise Cemetery year-to-date was \$59,150. In March, Mr. Mohler will give his annual report. Discussion was held.

2009 ACTIVITY UPDATE

Mr. Mohler said that leaf removal went well, and that those leaves were being composted at both cemeteries. Dirt filling of the draws continued. Concrete work was done this summer, as well as curb work. More clearing took place, and trees and bushes were planted where the cedar trees were removed. Roads were re-graded and bushes were trimmed as well. Discussion was held.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Mohler stated that there was some concern about the amount of advertisement being done for the Memorial Day Program held at Sunset Cemetery. The City of Manhattan will not pay to advertise the event but will put the information on the City's Channel 3 and on the City's website. The event is actually provided by the American Legion. Discussion was held.

The meeting was adjourned. It was determined that the next meeting would be held on Thursday, March 18, 2010.
