

CEMETERY ADVISORY BOARD

The following members of the Cemetery Advisory Board were present: Ms. Judy Atwood, Mr. Lawrence Pollack, Mr. Dennis Irvin, Mr. Stephen Konz, Ms. Deborah Saroff, and Mr. Eric Londeen. Mr. Patrick Gormely was absent. Also present at this meeting were Mr. Mike Mohler, Cemetery Sexton, and Mrs. Buffy Woodward, Administrative Assistant.

Mr. Irvin called the meeting to order.

MINUTES

It was moved by Mr. Londeen, seconded by Mr. Pollack to approve the minutes. On vote, motion carried 6-0.

SEXTON'S REPORT

Mr. Mohler explained that revenue for Sunset Cemetery year-to-date was \$2,600; revenue for Sunrise Cemetery year-to-date was \$20,850.

The City Commission approved the purchase of two new Hustler mowers. Two old mowers were traded in. Memorial Day went well, but might not have been as well attended.

The Park Planner has been working on the layout of Sunrise Cemetery. Section J has been completed. No flooding or drainage problems occurred at the cemeteries after the last big rains. Additional trees will be planted in the near future.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Mr. Irvin opened the floor for nominations and election of officers. It was moved by Mr. Konz, seconded by Mr. Pollack, that Mr. Londeen be nominated for Board Chair. The nomination was accepted by consensus. On vote, motion carried 5-1, with the no vote being Mr. Londeen. It was moved by Mr. Londeen, seconded by Mr. Pollack, that Mr. Konz be nominated for Vice-Chair. The nomination was accepted by consensus. On vote, motion carried 6-0.

NEW BUSINESS

Ms. Atwood will be resigning her position on the Board. She is moving out of state. The Board wished her well, and thanked her for her service.

The meeting was adjourned. It was determined that the next meeting would be held on Thursday, September 16, 2010.
