The following members of the Cemetery Advisory Board were present: Mr. Eric Londeen, Mr. Dennis Irvin, Ms. Donna Schenck-Hamlin, Ms. Judy Atwood, Mr. Patrick Gormely, and Mr. Stephan Konz. Ms. Schenck-Hamlin called the meeting to order.

SEXTON'S REPORT

Mr. Mohler explained that revenue, as of February 28, 2005, for Sunset Cemetery was \$2,395 and \$5,350 for Sunrise Cemetery. The 2004 revenue for Sunset Cemetery was \$13,375 and \$68,110 for Sunrise Cemetery.

Mr. Mohler discussed the projects/activities that happened in 2004. He also discussed the 2005 Capital Improvements Program.

SINGING TOWER

Ms. Schenck-Hamlin presented the Board with a selection of music of bells/chimes. The Board listened to the music and approved the selections that were presented.

It was moved by Ms. Schenck-Hamlin, seconded by Mr. Londeen to play *Stars and Stripes Forever* on July 4, 2005, at the normal time.
