

MINUTES
CEMETERY ADVISORY BOARD
PARKS AND RECREATION CONFERENCE ROOM
MARCH 18, 1999
4:00 P.M.

Present were the following members of the Cemetery Advisory Board: Mr. Stephan Konz, Ms. Martha Gray, and Mrs. Alice Stockwell. Ms. Judy Atwood, Mr. Dennis Irvin, Mr. Don Rathbone, and Mr. Eric Londeen were absent at this meeting. Also present at this meeting were Mr. Mike Mohler, Cemetery Sexton, and Mrs. Debbie Dugan, Office Manager.

The meeting was called to order. It was moved by Ms. Gray, seconded by Mr. Konz to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on December 17, 1998. On vote, motion carried 3-0.

SEXTON'S REPORT

Mr. Mohler explained that the 1998 revenue for Sunset Cemetery was \$13,939 and for Sunrise Cemetery was \$36,395 for a combined total of \$50,334. The revenue, as of February 1999, for Sunrise is \$4,950 and Sunset is \$2,390.

Mr. Mohler explained that 17 Military Markers have been set. The graves at Sunset Cemetery have been seeded.

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Konz inquired about the Singing Tower. Mr. Mohler explained that he had not received any new information on the project.

Mr. Mohler explained that the light for the flag pole would be in place for Memorial Day.

NEW BUSINESS

Mrs. Stockwell inquired about more cremation lots being sold. Mr. Mohler explained that single lots have been sold as cremation lots and two urns are being placed in them. Mr. Konz suggested that cremation trends be discussed at a future meeting. Mrs. Stockwell also suggested that future plans for building a mausoleum be discussed at a future meeting.

It was moved by Mr. Konz, seconded by Ms. Gray to adjourn the meeting. On vote, motion carried 3-0.
