

MINUTES  
CEMETERY ADVISORY BOARD

MARCH 28, 2002

The following members of the Cemetery Advisory Board were present: Mr. Patrick Gormely, Mr. Eric Londeen, Mr. Dennis Irvin, Ms. Donna Schenck-Hamlin, and Mr. Stephan Konz. - Revenue Sunset Cemetery - \$44,395 as of December 31, 2001; \$15,870 as of the end of February 2002
- Revenue Sunrise Cemetery - \$11,270 as of December 31, 2001; \$2,265 as of the end of February 2002
- Grave seeding

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Mohler gave an update on the Singing Tower.

Discussion was held on what type of music will be played. It was moved by Mr. Londeen, seconded by Mr. Konz to recommend that the music be played approximately one minute at 6:00 p.m. and to name a liaison to work with Kansas State University on music types and come up with chimes and bells (non-religious). On vote, motion carried 5-0.

It was moved by Mr. Londeen, seconded by Mr. Gormely to recommend Ms. Schenck-Hamlin to serve as the liaison to work with the Music Department and the Electrical Engineering Department at Kansas State University. On vote, motion carried 5-0.
