

MINUTES  
CEMETERY ADVISORY BOARD  
PARKS AND RECREATION CONFERENCE ROOM  
JUNE 15, 2000  
4:00 P.M.

The following members of the Cemetery Advisory Board were present: Mr. Don Rathbone, Mrs. Alice Stockwell, Mr. Eric Londeen, Ms. Judy Atwood, and Ms. Martha Gray. Mr. Dennis Irvin and Mr. Stephan Konz were absent at this meeting. Also present at this meeting was Mr. Mike Mohler, Cemetery Sexton; Mr. Jerry Dishman, Park Superintendent; and Mrs. Debbie Dugan, Office Manager.

Mr. Londeen called the meeting to order. It was moved by Mr. Rathbone, seconded by Mrs. Stockwell to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on March 16, 2000. On vote, motion carried 3-0.

SEXTON'S REPORT

Mr. Mohler discussed the following:

- Revenue Sunset Cemetery - \$3,745.
- Revenue Sunrise - \$14,305

The Board complimented the Cemetery Staff on the appearance of the cemeteries on Memorial Day.

CEMETERY FENCE

The Cemetery Fence project will be discussed at the City Commission Meeting on June 20, 2000. Five companies submitted bids for the fence project. Bella Fence, Junction City, Kansas, submitted the low bid. There will be two openings; one at Oakdale and one at Edgerton. Mr. Mohler explained that landscaping would be done around the fence. Mrs. Gray inquired about donating bushes for this project. It was suggested that a list of appropriate bushes that could be used around the fence be presented to the Board.

The Board inquired about the vandalism at Sunset Cemetery since school has not been in session. Mr. Mohler explained that things have been going well.

Mr. Rathbone left early due to prior commitments.

OTHER BUSINESS

The Board inquired about the letter to the City Commission requesting that the Cemetery Advisory Board report directly to the City Commission instead of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. The Board asked Mrs. Dugan to prepare the letter for Mr. Irvin's signature.
