

CEMETERY ADVISORY BOARD
CITY COMMISSION ROOM
JUNE 19, 2003
4:00 P.M.

The following members of the Cemetery Advisory Board were present: Mr. Eric Londeen, Ms. Judy Atwood, Mr. Patrick Gormely, Mr. Dennis Irvin, Mr. Stephan Konz, and Ms. Donna Schenck-Hamlin. Mr. Tom Roth was absent at this meeting. Also present at this meeting was Mr. Mike Mohler, Cemetery Sexton, and Mrs. Debbie Dugan, Administrative Supervisor.

Mr. Londeen called the meeting to order.

It was moved by Ms. Atwood, seconded by Ms. Schenck-Hamlin to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on March 27, 2003. On vote, motion carried 6-0.

REVENUE REPORT

Mr. Mohler explained that the revenue, as of May 31, for Sunrise Cemetery was \$20,175, and for Sunset Cemetery was \$7,575.

SINGING TOWER

Mr. Londeen thanked Mr. Gormely for gathering information/input from the neighborhood on the Singing Tower.

The Board explained that both "test scenarios" have been performed on the Singing Tower.

Mr. Londeen explained that there are two options to report information on the Singing Tower to the City Commission. The first option would be to place an item on the City Commission's agenda with the second option to place the information in the City Commission's reading file.

Mr. Gormely suggested that music be played on July 4, 2003 by getting immediate permission from the City Commission or Mayor. Other Board Members were not in favor of attempting to play music this July 4, but preferred instead to wait for general permission to determine the Singing Tower policy.

It was moved by Mr. Irvin, seconded by Ms. Atwood that as per instruction by the City Commission, tests have been performed on the Singing Tower as requested. The Board recommends giving the Cemetery Advisory Board authority to make further adjustments as deemed necessary. On vote, motion carried 6-0.

The meeting was adjourned.
