M. Wesch called the meeting to order at 3:35 p.m. on January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

**Introductions:**

1. Wyatt Thompson, Park Planner for the City of Manhattan came to the meeting to introduce himself and talk about several upcoming projects. He mentioned the pedestrian orientated lighting around City Park and sidewalk renovations to Triangle Park. The committee gave input on those projects and suggested that he attend meetings to present on any project that would have bike or pedestrian amenities.

**Staff Reports:**

First, staff presented to the Parks and Recreations Advisory Board to gain input on the 2013 Bike Boulevard projects that were designed to go through City Park.
