

CEMETERY ADVISORY BOARD
REGULAR MEETING

The following members of the Cemetery Advisory Board were present: Mr. Lawrence Pollack, Mr. Lawrence Fry, Mr. Eric Londeen, Ms. Deborah Saroff, and Mr. Patrick Gormely. Mr. Stephen Konz and Mr. Dennis Irvin were absent. Also present at this meeting were Mr. Curt Loupe, Director of Parks and Recreation, Mr. Mike Mohler, Cemetery Sexton, and Mrs. Buffy Woodward, Administrative Assistant.

Mr. Pollack called the meeting to order.

MINUTES

It was moved by Mr. Fry, seconded by Ms. Saroff to approve the December minutes. On vote, motion carried 5-0.

SEXTON'S REPORT

Mr. Mohler explained that revenue for Sunset Cemetery year-to-date was \$0; revenue for Sunrise Cemetery year-to-date was \$9,300.

The crew has been busy prepping and seeding graves. A few more mowers need prepped. Work on the Sunrise Cemetery expansion project is on-going. The Cemetery Office has been moved into the Cemetery House.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Mr. Pollack opened the floor for nominations and election of officers. It was moved by Mr. Londeen, seconded by Mr. Fry, that Mr. Pollack be nominated for Board Chair and Ms. Saroff be nominated for Vice Chair. The nomination was accepted by acclamation.

Mr. Mohler stated that he has been working on the Singing Tower with an engineering student from K-State. The student has been up every week, and is writing a how-to guide for the next student. He will reformat the music to play on the system. John Phillip Sousa marches will be played on Memorial Day by the Singing Tower from 12:00-1:00 p.m. The student has also been made aware of the lights that are out.
