1. ENVIRONS REVIEW

Four & Twenty Blackbirds, 427A Poyntz Ave: Sign Permit (within environs of Riley County Courthouse, Manhattan Carnegie Library, Lyda-Jean Apartment House, and Manhattan State Bank)

John Kice explained that the proposed sign would not be illuminated. The sign will be painted plastic or vinyl placed on an aluminum sheet.

After discussion, Roberts moved that the Board find that the proposal meets the Standards and Guidelines for Evaluating the Effect of Projects on Environs and will not encroach upon, damage or destroy the listed historic property or its environs.

Hill seconded the motion, which passed on a vote of 4-0.
