1. Consider the minutes of the March 28, 2005 Historic Resources Board meeting.

Taylor moved that the Board approve the minutes. Borst seconded the motion, which passed on a vote of 7-0.

2. Discussion of Cultural Resource Survey Report:

- b. Providing information to property owners.**

Taylor spoke in recognition of the efforts of Foerster and Lynn-Sherow in making presentations about historic preservation and the Survey Report. Foerster has made presentations to the Manhattan Lions Club, the Manhattan Association of Realtors, the League of Women Voters, the Manhattan Arts Center and the Manhattan Preservation Alliance, the Manhattan Rotary Club, the KSU Wranglers, and Sertoma. Lynn-Sherow has made presentations at the Manhattan Public Library and to the Kiwanis.

The Board expressed their desire to present the Survey Report to the City Commission as soon as could be arranged. Moeller said he has been informed that it may be a few months before the Board could present to the City Commission, but that it may be possible to present at a joint City/County meeting. The Board expressed interest in presenting at both forums.

The Board discussed drafting a letter directed to property owners within the survey area making them aware of the opportunities that are available for properties potentially eligible for historic recognition.

3. Other Matters:

The Board discussed ways to recognize properties that are already listed on either the national, state, or local register, such as through press releases.

Brockson informed the Board about an open house that Seven Dolores Church would be having the weekend of April 30th/May 1st for the house that has been renovated at 618 Pierre Street.
