WARNER MEMORIAL PARK

Mr. DeWeese explained that City Administration addressed each element in the “draft” plan. The Board discussed the following mission statement: To provide a safe park with minimal development that allows the community the opportunity to use and enjoy Warner Memorial Park.

The Board held discussion on Ecology – erosion; trees, vegetation, and soils; cedars; wildlife; encroachment; and assessment of the park; and Amenities – restrooms and trails. The Board approved with general consensus the above items.
