1. Core Downtown Revitalization Committee

Jason Hilgers provided an update on the Core Downtown Revitalization Committee (CDRC).

Hill moved that the Board put forward Ray Weisenburger as a nominee for the Mayor to consider appointing to the CDRC, with Lynn-Sherow as an alternative choice.

Mohr seconded the motion, which passed on a vote of 6-0.

2. Presentation from Lauren Ritterbush, Associate Professor at Kansas State University, regarding archaeological sites in the Manhattan area

Ritterbush discussed existing legal protections afforded archaeological sites and suggested that efforts be made to raise awareness among developers to ensure protection of sensitive sites in the Manhattan area. Ritterbush and the Board discussed developing a list of sites that can be made available to the public.

3. Project Updates

Brockson and Roberts updated the Board about their efforts regarding historic markers.

4. Register of Historic Kansas Places: Washington and Julia Marlatt Homestead, 1600 College Avenue

The Board was informed that the Kansas Historic Sites Board of Review has approved the nomination of the Marlatt Homestead.

5. Consider the minutes of the August 28, 2006 Historic Resources Board Meetings.

Roberts moved that the Board approve the minutes. Hill seconded the motion, which passed on a vote of 6-0.

6. Other Matters

The Board held a discussion regarding the old K-177 bridge piers. Roberts moved that the Board go on record advising the City Commission to request the Historic Resources Board's input before making any decisions on the bridge piers. Hill seconded the motion, which passed on a vote of 6-0.
